Attention Dog Owners—ALL dogs must be vaccinated against rabies and have a current one-year or three-year certificate in order to obtain a dog license. It is New York State Law that ALL dogs be vaccinated and licensed by no later than 4 months of age.

Attention Cat & Ferret Owners—It is New York State Law that ALL cats and ferrets in the county be vaccinated by no later than 4 months of age to prevent rabies.

NOTE: For cats and dogs previously immunized against rabies, you **MUST** bring **proof of immunization** in order to be issued a 3-year certificate. Without proof, a 1-year certificate will be issued. Ferrets must be vaccinated annually.

All animals must either be leashed or in a top-opening carrier and accompanied by a person 16 years of age, or older.
