

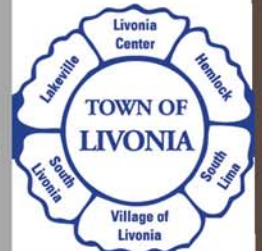
ANOTHER FREE WATERSHED EDUCATION CENTER PRESENTATION AT VITALE PARK
