

**Town of Groveland
Local Law Public Hearing**

The Town Board will be holding a public hearing on November 9, 2017 at 8:00 p.m. at the Groveland Town Hall, 4955 Aten Road, Livingston County to introduce Regulations of Solar Farms Local Laws. The Town Board of the Town of Groveland The Town Board of the Town of Groveland enacts this Local Law under the authority granted by New York State Constitution Article IX, Section 2(c) (6) and (10); Local Governments Law Section 10(1), (6) and (7); Municipal Home Rule Law Section 10(1) (i) and (ii), 10(1)(a)(6), (11), (12) and (14).

The Town of Groveland finds that solar energy is an abundant, renewable and nonpolluting energy resource and that its conversion to electricity will reduce the dependence on nonrenewable energy resources and decrease the air and water pollution that results from the use of conventional energy sources. Solar Farms also enhance the reliability and power quality of the power grid, reduce peak power demands, and help diversify the state's energy supply portfolio.
